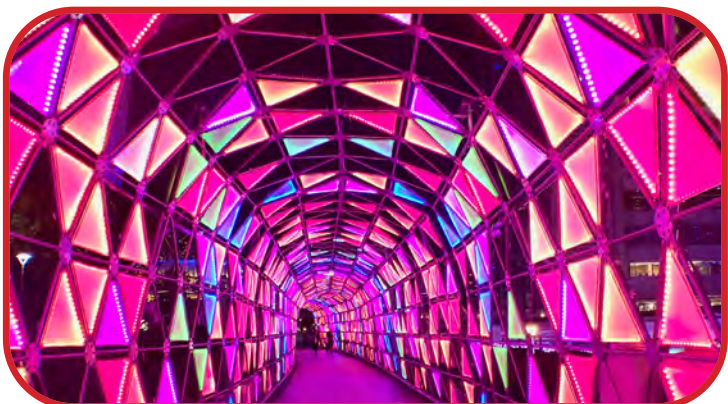

# Itinerary

## Day 1: (Sun) Dec 21 – Honolulu Depart Honolulu

→ Meet the Panda Travel representative at the airline's check-in counters 3 hours prior to departure.

## Day 2: (Mon) Dec 22 – Haneda-Maihama

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Arrive at Haneda Airport. Meet your English speaking local guide at the arrival lobby before transferring to the hotel.

→ Welcome to Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama, the official Tokyo Disney Resort® Hotel! Take advantage of the hotel's direct access to the Disney Resort Line monorail system. The monorail, which loops around the perimeter of the resort, will make several stops, including at the doorsteps of Tokyo Disneyland and DisneySea. If you'd like to explore **Ikspiari**—a vibrant shopping, dining, and entertainment hub—please let your local guide know and they will assist you.

## Day 3: (Tue) Dec 23 – Maihama/Tokyo Disneyland (B)

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 8:15am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for the monorail ride to Tokyo Disneyland.

→ 9:00am – Get ready for an exhilarating day at **Tokyo Disneyland!** Explore the many Tokyo Disneyland exclusive attractions like its glass covered Victorian-style indoor World Bazaar and the Beauty and the Beast mini-land that stretches from Belle's village square to Beast's Castle. Don't miss out on the spectacular PhilharMagic show and new rides like The Happy Ride with Baymax! In between attractions, snack on a chewy Stormtrooper mochi or hot, fresh popcorn featuring flavors limonorrailke curry, cookie cream, and garlic shrimp. Enjoy making fun memories today!

→ Return to hotel – The monorail will transport you back to the hotel when you decide to return and rest up for the next day's Disney adventure.

## Day 4: (Wed) Dec 24 – Maihama/Tokyo DisneySea (B)

Grand Nikko Tokyo Bay Maihama (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ The day is yours at **Tokyo DisneySea**, the 4th most visited theme park in the world! Excitingly, you'll step foot in the park's newly opened Northern European inspired expansion: Fantasy Springs. With rides, attractions, and foods from the massively popular Frozen, Tangled, and Peter Pan movies, you'll find Arendelle Castle in Frozen Kingdom, the floating lantern festival in Rapunzel's Forest, a pirate ship in Peter

Pan's Neverland, and more! But the fun doesn't end there... drift along the Mediterranean Harbor on a Venetian gondola, descend to the ocean's depths in the 20,000 Leagues Under the Sea submarine, explore caverns of mystery in a subterranean vehicle on the Journey to the Center of the Earth ride, and navigate a watercraft in Aquatopia. Fuel up with a gyoza dog, a tiramisu ice cream sandwich, or a tempura assortment plate. Have fun - Sea you later!

## Day 5: (Thu) Dec 25 – Maihama-Tokyo (B)

Tokyo Dome Hotel (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 9:00am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for Tokyo.

→ 9:30am – Start the day at the **Urayasu City Folk Museum**, a beacon of cultural heritage and community pride that showcases the vibrant history of Urayasu City.

→ 11:00am – Our next visit: **Aeon Mall Makuhari Shin-Toshin/Costco**, one of the largest Aeon Malls in Japan! The complex is so enormous, it's divided into 4 malls: the Active Mall (sports focused shops + a sports theme park), the Family Mall (family focused shops + play area and toy stores for children), Pet Mall (essentials for our fur babies!), and the Grand Mall (main hall with everything you need including a supermarket, fashion store, and cinema!). Within the sub- malls, you'll find two Daiso stores, a 300 yen shop, and so much more!

→ 2:00pm – From here, head to the bustling shopping streets in the **Asakusa** district. Discover this shopper's paradise, which includes stalls selling local snacks, restaurants, shopping centers, and a colossal 24 hour seven-story Don Quijote.

→ 4:00pm – Are you ready for an exciting **Taiko drum experience?** Learn about Taiko and take part in a hands-on drumming activity that highlights this ancient art form.

→ 5:30pm – Arrive at the **Tokyo Dome Hotel**, where we'll be staying for the remainder of our tour. Conveniently located, the hotel is steps away from **Tokyo Dome City**, an incredible entertainment complex featuring thrilling amusement park attractions and the iconic Tokyo Dome, home field of the Yomiuri Giants baseball theme park.

While here, travel through space in a fun VR facility; overload on cuteness at Tokyo's largest indoor petting zoo with over 300 animals from 50 different species; throw strikes at a 40-lane bowling center; glide in skates at one of Tokyo's largest indoor roller skating rinks; and much more (please note that admission tickets are not included). You may also find yourself indulging in a variety of shopping and dining options or relaxing at the Spa LaQua hot spring facility.

As night falls, prepare to be dazzled by the Winter

Illumination, a must-see attraction with stunning lights and fun displays of holiday cheer.

### Day 7: (Sat) Dec 27 – Tokyo (B)

Tokyo Dome Hotel (Free Wi-Fi)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 9:30am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for a full day tour in Tokyo.

→ 10:00am – This morning begins at **Tsukiji Outer Market**, a renowned bucketlist spot for its fresh seafood and vibrant street food scene. While the inner auction market relocated to Toyosu in 2018, the charm remains in its outer market. Be sure to enjoy all that the outer market has to offer, from seasonal produce and candy tasting to knife-making artisan shops.

→ 12:30pm – Ever wonder how the mouthwatering food displayed in restaurant windows are made to look so lifelike? Let's find out at the interactive **"food sample" making workshop**, where you'll handcraft your very own realistic foods.

→ 1:45pm – During your visit to **Sunshine City** in Ikebukuro, take the time to explore over hundreds of shops, restaurants, and attractions. Don't miss the Sunshine Aquarium for an up-close look at marine life, and be sure to visit the observatory deck for breathtaking views of Tokyo. The complex also includes a planetarium and an indoor theme park, Namjatown, making it a perfect spot for shopping and entertainment.

→ 4:30pm – Time to experience the enchanting **TOKYO MEGA ILLUMI**, a spectacular illumination event. This outdoor exhibition features breathtaking light displays that transform the landscape into a magical wonderland. Walk through illuminated pathways adorned with intricate light sculptures and enjoy themed areas showcasing seasonal lights. It's a perfect way to capture the beauty of Tokyo at night and create unforgettable memories.

→ 6:30pm – Return to hotel.

→ After breakfast, enjoy your free day at leisure!

### Day 9: (Mon) Dec 29 – Tokyo-Haneda-Honolulu (B)

→ Breakfast at hotel.

→ 9:30am – Meet your guide at the hotel lobby for a full day tour in Tokyo.

→ 10:00am – Begin the day with some reality bending magic at **teamLab Planets Tokyo**. Using technology and perspective, this immersive museum takes visitors through labyrinth-like rooms filled with flower fields, interactive play areas where you can catch digital animals, jump on pod blocks and experience other mesmerizing digital art displays.

→ 12:30pm – Next, grab lunch on your own at **Toyosu Senkyaku Banrai**. Opened in Feb 2024 and inspired by the historic streets of Tokyo, this Edo themed multi-story shopping and entertainment center treats visitors to a variety of eateries featuring specialty foods like Toyosu's signature fresh seafood and produce.

→ 2:00pm – Enjoy your last minute shopping at **Divercity Shopping Center**. Located on the artificial island of Odaiba. This unique and massive landmark is one of the best shopping, dining, and entertainment complexes in Tokyo. Don't forget to take a moment to snap a photo in front of the famous Gundam Statue, towering at nearly 80 feet high.

→ Transfer to Haneda Airport to begin our check-in process via Hawaiian Airlines for our flight home.

→ Arrive in Honolulu (same day).

## Payment Policy

- » **Reserve with \$75 per person deposit. Refundable up to 65 days prior to departure date October 17, 2025.**
- » **Final payment due by October 29, 2025. Package is non-refundable after this date.**

- » Land Tour costs are based on current currency conversion rates, which are subject to change.

- » Not Included in the tour: Gratuities for local English speaking guide; additional baggage fee charges from the airlines; alcohol and soft drinks with meals.
